How Many Medicare Days Does A Qualified Patient Receive?

A qualified Medicare patient is eligible for up to 100 days of skilled services.

How Does A Medicare Patient Qualify?

Be entitled to Medicare Part A.

Meet a three day prior hospital stay requirement.

Be admitted to a skilled facility within 30 days after being discharged from a hospital.

Require skilled nursing services and/or skilled rehabilitative services on a daily basis (rehab must be five days per week).

Have days available in the current benefit period.

Be certified by a physician as needing skilled care.

Understanding Medicare Skilled Services

Medicare Skilled Services are defined as any care which requires skilled nursing (extensive wound care and care of new enteral feeding devices) or skilled rehabilitation services (physical, speech and audiology, and occupational therapy) that must be performed and supervised by professionals in accordance with physicians orders. Many times, these services are required as part of a short-term recovery from injuries or medical conditions.
